NFTRA INVITATIONAL HORSE SHOW 2010

To be held on:

Saturday June 19th and Sunday June 20th

Open to all Therapeutic Riding riders who are registered in a Therapeutic Riding program.

For our first invitational show the North Fraser Therapeutic Riding Association has decided to go to the grass roots level and give an opportunity for all riders who do not usually attend a horse show, due to long hours of waiting, a chance to experience participating in a horse show. This show is designed to have the rider come and compete in three different events within a 1 hour time period receive a ribbon and then be able to go home. Riding Associations can decide to come either on one day or both days depending on how many riders in their association who wish to attend.

RIDING VENUE:

- At the North Fraser Therapeutic Riding Association barn;

FORMAT:

Riders attend for a 1 hour period. Riders will participate in each of the following classes; Dressage test, Obstacle Course and a timed Pole Bending. There will be up to eight riders per hour. The riders will be placed in groups according to their riding ability.

DRESSAGE TEST: (A) Walk Only (B) Walk/with a Straight line Trot(C) Walk with an advanced trot

- There are three tests to choose from. A Walk only, Walk with a straight line of trot in each direction and an advanced trot test.
- Judges are looking at Sitting balance and use of the reins and control of horse.
- For the tests with trot the trot can be sitting or rising which ever the rider is more comfortable with

OBSTACLE COURSE

- All obstacle course tests are completed at a walk.
- Judges are looking for obedience of horse through out obstacles and balance of rider on the horse while completing all tasks.
- Obstacles will include a rope gait, bridge, keyhole, bending, broom ball, walk over cavelletti, picking up and dropping objects off of barrels and into buckets. Back up of 3 steps in a channel and a halt for 5 seconds.

POLE BENDING

- This is a timed event. The rider bends up and back through a series of 5 poles. The rider will pass through a start and finish line.

AWARDS:

All riders will receive a ribbon in the placement order. The placings will be decided by scores from all three events. Ribbons will be handed out by the class sponsors.

COST:

The cost of the show is \$50.00 for the three classes. Riders will be contacted by the NFTRA office with their riding time one week prior to show date. No refunds will be given for cancellations or no shows.

FOOD:

There will be a concession open sponsored by the Kiwanis Club of Maple Ridge.

DRESS CODE:

Riders are encouraged to wear jodhpurs, riding boots and a jacket but this is not mandatory. As long as the rider is neat and tidy. White shirt, a vest can be worn over top of the shirt, dark pants, hair tied back, boot with a heel or Devonshire boots on the stirrup, proper fitting helmet. Non riding jackets can be worn as long as they are zippered up.

STABLING:

We have limited stalls available but we do have paddock access. Depending on how many horses each barn is bringing and if overnight stabling is required. Please call the office for more stabling information.

MOUNTING:

We have two mounting blocks with one mounting block which has a mechanical lift. Riders who require a mechanical lift will be in a grouping with only 6 riders due to required mounting time.

DISMOUNTING:

Once the rider has completed all three events we will ask the riders to dismount and then receive their ribbon on foot. This gives the horses a chance to rest in between groups and time for tack changes if necessary.

RIDE TIMES:

Ride times for each of the riders will be sent to each riding facility minimum of one week prior to the show. Cancellations are to be done through the NFTA office.
